The ORMDI team within the PSI Health Sector is currently seeking an intern who will be tasked with supporting two distinct Authority to Operate (ATO) processes. This involves various responsibilities, including the creation of Plan of Action and Milestones (POA&Ms), development of architecture diagrams, and the formulation of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). Additionally, the intern will utilize eMASS for managing the authorization boundaries of both projects, facilitating the request and evaluation of scans, and subsequently assessing the results.

In close collaboration with the Security Analyst, the intern will ensure comprehensive information completion and accurate upload to eMASS, while diligently assigning Common Control Identifiers (CCIs). Moreover, they will liaise closely with the System Administrator and System Engineers to gather and provide evidentiary support for CCIs. Additionally, the intern will be responsible for setting up code scanning tools, reviewing the outcomes, and collaborating with other team members to devise strategies for addressing identified issues.

This role offers a professional opportunity for the intern to gain hands-on experience in cybersecurity compliance processes within a dynamic environment. Working alongside experienced professionals, the intern will contribute to the successful attainment of ATOs, thereby ensuring the integrity and security of critical healthcare systems and data.
