The primary focus will be on migrating CATS data to E2 and subsequently developing a robust data lake infrastructure. This involves meticulously cleansing the data across bronze, silver, and gold tiers, ensuring its quality and integrity. Furthermore, the intern will play a pivotal role in transitioning the reporting tool to connect seamlessly with the data lake, catering to the heavy reporting demands of ORMDI.

As an integral member of our agile team, the intern will participate in sprints aimed at advancing these pivotal projects. Additionally, they may be tasked with assisting in the creation of requirements for various ORMDI product lines. This entails analyzing existing applications, collaborating with other analysts, and recommending enhancements or setting up reports to meet user needs.

Measurable outcomes for this role include providing support to the team in migrating CATS data to E2, conducting testing on the E2 system for data migration, and contributing to the construction of the Data Lake. Additionally, the intern will actively participate in Agile Team activities, including sprint participation and application reviews, with a focus on suggesting improvements to applications and reporting processes.
